**FEARLESS, WRITING**

**January 5:** “Fearless Writing”, to be presented by Ellen Nielsen, English teacher at Dayton State College. If you can think and talk, you can write! Using techniques such as free-writing, group writing and writing very short poems, participants will learn how to enjoy writing more and dreading it less. Bring a writing pad, or notebook, and a pen.

**WHY I AM AN AGNOSTIC AND NEITHER AN ATHEIST NOR A BELIEVER**

**January 12:** “Why I Am An Agnostic and Neither an Atheist Nor a Believer”, to be presented by Dan Kennedy, Ed.D. retired psychologist and educator. This program, using a lecture-discussion format, will compare agnosticism, atheism and religious belief, and will provide a rationale for the presenter’s choice of agnosticism.

**WHITEHEAD’S PROCESS PHILOSOPHY OF GOD**

**January 26:** “Whitehead’s Process Philosophy of God”, to be presented by Ellen Chen, Ph.D., retired professor of philosophy. This program, using a lecture-discussion format, will examine the mathematician and philosopher Alford North Whitehead’s conceptions of God and reality, relating these to process theology.

**February 2:** “Four Artists and Their Work”, to be presented by Donna Jordan and Steve McLaughlin, local “Art Activists”. Four well-known artists will talk about where their art has led them and how they see their work, and will invite your participation in their explorations.

**February 9:** “Building the World We Dream About”, to be presented by Pastor Bud Murphy. This program will address how we can take steps to dismantle the often invisible racism that sometimes exists in our communities, showing how we can welcome all cultures into all facets of our lives. There will be a discussion period following the presentation.

**ORMOND BEACH CONNECTS WITH SISTER CITIES IN MEXICO AND FRANCE**

**February 23:** “Ormond Beach Connects with Sister Cities in Mexico and France”, to be presented by Carolyn West and Barbara Eveleigh, retired educators. There will be a question and answer period after the presentation.
