RE Begins Guest At Your Table, Sunday, November 22nd



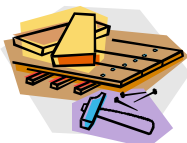
Each year on the Sunday before Thanksgiving, many friends and families in UU congregations across the U.S. participate in the tradition of Guest at Your Table.

Here's how it works: Each participant takes a Guest at Your Table box home and places it in a prominent spot, often at the family meal table. When family and friends gather to enjoy their blessings, they can reflect, and then give generously to a “guest” in need. At the close of the program (this year on Jan. 3rd), the boxes are returned to UU and the monies are collectively sent to the UU Service Committee.
